$$v > \sqrt{\frac{2MG}{r}} \quad (1)$$

where:

v – escape velocity, $\text{m}\cdot\text{s}^{-1}$,

M – mass of body from which object is projected, kg,

G – universal gravitational constant, $\text{N}\cdot\text{m}^2\cdot\text{kg}^{-2}$,

r – radius of body from which object is projected, m.
